 - E. A BDR to address *Reno Newspapers v. Sheriff*, 126 Nev. Adv. Op. No. 23 (July 1, 2010), to amend NRS 202.3662 to provide that the identity of the permittee of a concealed firearms permit, and any post-permit records of investigation, suspension, or revocation, are confidential by law.*
